A Place for Hope and Healing

Our Services

Here at Imagine we offer multiple levels of care from assessments and individual therapy to our structured Intensive Outpatient Programs. Our services are performed by Licensed Professional Counselors, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists and Board Certified Psychiatrists.

Intensive Outpatient Programs

Adult IOP with Buprenorphine Tract is designed to offer treatment to persons who can maintain chemical abstinence in an outpatient setting. Persons assessed to be appropriate for this level of care receive individual and group therapy, a psychiatric assessment, medication management, an individualized treatment plan, relapse prevention therapy, Family Program and continuing care. This program meets Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 5-8pm. The duration of the program is 6-10 weeks.

Adolescent and Young Adult IOP is designed to meet the specific needs of young people with psychiatric and behavioral disorders as well as drug and alcohol abuse and addiction. Components include assessment and referral services, group therapy, individual therapy, career and vocational counseling, psychological testing, family program, psychiatric evaluation, pharmacotherapy, drug screening and aftercare. The program meets Monday – Thursday in the early evenings. Duration is typically 12 weeks.

Individual Services

We offer individual counseling and psychotherapy for all ages. Areas of expertise include depression, anxiety, grief, panic disorder, addiction, substance abuse, identity issues, parenting, behavior disorders, anger management, stress management, sleep disorders, spirituality issues and developmental concerns.
